Life Member Nomination

The life membership nomination and approval procedure has been updated and approved at the national executive pre-convention meeting in August. New forms were generated: Life Member Notice of Nomination for Life Membership, Nomination for Life Membership, Life Member Nominee Questionnaire, and Life Member Checklist for Provincial Council. These changes will become effective May 1, 2016. A substantive change in procedure is to be followed so be prepared to review the materials carefully and keep these on file for reference. Life membership is an honour that entails responsibility and is not intended to be a reward for years of service or as a retirement gift. Please note that nominations for Life Membership only come from the Provincial or the Diocesan level.

Development Funds

I would like to encourage diocesan/provincial councils to plan leadership development for members. Subsidies are available for League development (check the website <u>www.cwl.ca</u>, <u>Member Bursaries and Council Subsidies</u>). Read and carefully follow the guidelines provided. This is a great way to boost membership by hosting an orientation or development program that would meet the needs of your members. Continue to promote and encourage attendance at League functions, development days, workshops, training days and conventions.

Catch the Fire & S'Mores Workshops

Another valuable tool for promoting the League and increasing our membership is to host a workshop on "Catch the Fire" or "S'Mores". This will give the ladies a comprehensive view of what CWL is all about. The facilitators from across the province are looking forward to being invited by a council to give these presentations.

Membership Drive

A reminder that membership packages for 2016 are scheduled to be distributed by Oct 15th. This is the time to encourage ladies in your parish to get their memberships as well as inviting new ladies to come and see what CWL has to offer. Remember that by increasing your membership, your council may be eligible for a "Father Walter Krewski" award based on the information below:

- **1.** The first award will go to the council which has the greatest number of new members in the previous year. (Please note: New members are only those who have never held a C.W.L. membership before)
- 2. The second award will go to the council which has the greatest overall increase in membership from the previous year
- **3.** The third award will go to the council which has the greatest **percentage** increase in membership in the previous year
