At our Provincial convention in June 2016, I had the pleasure of presenting three awards to three councils from the Edmonton Diocese that had achieved an increase in their membership from the previous year. Our Lady of the Angels council from Fort Saskatchewan had the greatest increase in new members. Parkland Holy Trinity council from Spruce Grove/Stony Plain had the greatest increase in membership, and St. Alphonsus council in Edmonton had the greatest percentage increase in membership. A total of 59 councils posted an increase in membership in the year 2015. Good work ladies! Please continue to promote the League and if you have an increase in membership for the year 2016, please ensure that the information is forward to me.
