"Spiritual Development Chair" Sisters:

I am absolutely thrilled that we will be working together to bring the presence of Christ to our councils. The theme One Heart, One Voice, One Mission will be our guidepost as we make this journey together. I encourage all of you to develop the national theme around the sacraments as **they** are **"our way of life."** A sacrament is to be lived... it is an outward sign instituted by Christ to give grace. There is never a time when we are not living them. Most of us think of a sacrament as something that happens at Church – an event – but on further reflection we realize that they are actually lived 24/7.... For example, when we receive Christ in his body and blood, we become what we eat and we become an outward sign bringing the presence of Christ to our families, the poor, our Church communities, etc. (We live out what we profess.) Through us, **our councils** should become outward signs of Christ's presence in our Church.

As we work on our spiritual programs let us ask ourselves: "How does my spiritual program help my sisters grow in their spirituality in order to become sacrament for one another?" By doing this, we begin to develop One Heart (the Sacred Heart of Jesus full of mercy), One Voice (His Voice found in His Word), and One Mission (His mission to build the kingdom of God).

I encourage you to evaluate your spiritual programs. What works and what should be retired? How much time is allotted to the spiritual program at your meetings – do you subscribe to the **1/3 principle**... 1/3 spiritual, 1/3 business and 1/3 fellowship, or in our case sister-ship. How do they help our members grow

in the **knowledge** of their faith;

call them to **prayer** outside the meeting;

become aware of how they are a living sacrament;

realize that each member is a gift that God has given to the world to help each other as pilgrims on a journey;

and do they call us to be One Heart, One Voice, One Mission.
