The budget can be a simple one page document outlining what your Council expects to earn and spend for the coming year. The report presented at the regular meeting will compare what was actually spent to what you expected to spend.

Although membership doesn't fall under our standing committee, we have a vested interest in it. Diocesan and Provincial councils do not fund raise, and therefore are dependent on *per capita* fees for our continued operations. Encourage new members and get your *per capita* fees in early.

Reporting time is just a couple of months away. Please strive for 100% reporting. Our National office cannot provide accurate figures without full reporting from parish to diocese to provincial. Also, a reminder to Parish Treasurers to complete the Report of National Voluntary Funds along with your regular year end Treasurer's report.
